What are the projects about?

Both projects aims at fostering the **digital skills** of **old adults aged 55 years and over**

ICT Skills 4 All targets those adults who have **minimal or no engagement** with digital technology.

ICT 4 Elderly focuses more on those adults who **already have some digital skills** and its aim is to upskills these competences.

SPECIAL ELEMENT:

The project aims to test which one is the best methodology between :

- the **inter-generational approach**, and
- the **peer-to-peer approach**.

- Use of the concept of **wikis**
- 24 people will be selected through a call for applicants and will take part in the piloting as **ambassadors of the project**.

What social impact will they have?

Both projects want to increase the **digital skills** of **older adults** across Europe and to show them the advantages of using new technologies as a way to **increase** their **autonomy** and to **tackle social isolation**.



ICT Skills 4 All: Lessons learned (1)

Review of **online resources**

- Provide data regarding their **usage**
- Great need to make the website more **visual** and more **user friendly** for the **specific target group**

Review of **in-person educational programs**

- **Peer-to-peer learning** and learning in groups are the **most common** learning methods available



ICT 4 Elderly : Lessons learned (2)

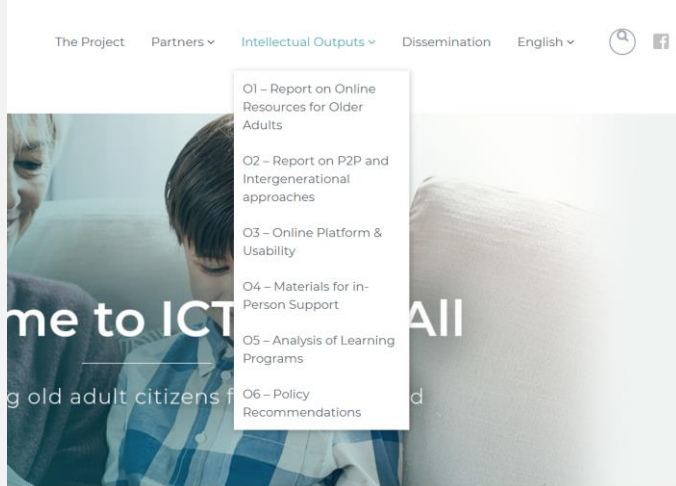
Decide specific competence areas and **define partners roles** before starting the collection of best practices existent

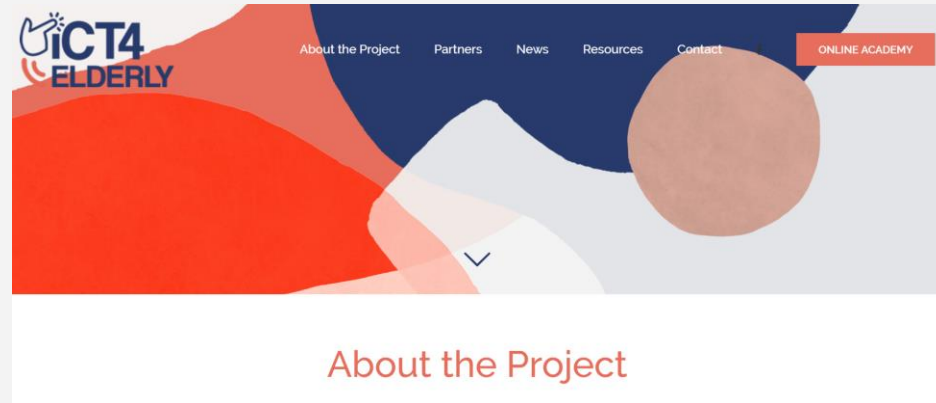
ICT Skills 4 All
